

How Do I Sign Up for a Learning Community?

1. Sign in to WebAdvisor using your user ID and password.
2. Click on “Students” and then on “Register for Sections.”
3. Click on “Express Register.”
4. Enter the class information given below for all of your learning community courses, as well as your other chosen courses and click “Submit.”
5. Review the information to make sure it is correct and click “OK.” Be certain that you are registered for BOTH courses or you will be withdrawn from the isolated learning community course in the first week of class.
6. Check “My Schedule” for registration results before logging out of WebAdvisor.
7. You can now log out of WebAdvisor.
