Peer Mentors will:

- Attend each assigned FF class
- Be a positive role model for the students
- Support students' use of the learning community as a resource
- Support the ideas of the course/textbook and encourage students to use the strategies
- Regularly provide students examples of times in which they struggled, why they struggled, what they did about it, and the outcome
- Participate in class discussion
- Aid students' awareness of and comfort with various support services on campus
- Arrange out-of-class visits to various offices on campus
- Arrange out-of-class study sessions
- Arrange out-of-class social events
- Encourage students to attend university social events
- Check in with students regarding academics
- Check in with students regarding adjustment to college and/or Las Vegas
- Assist with navigation of Ellucian GO, My NMHU, Degree Audit, Desire 2 Learn, etc.
- Provide weekly reports to graduate assistant who is advising the PM program
- Encourage pre-registration for Spring 15 semester
